First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **24.7.2020** and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **8.10.2020** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. There is meanwhile no communication from the appellant since the last hearing on 11.2.2021 compelling this Commission to conclude that he is satisfied with the information furnished.
- 4. Under the circumstances, there is no further cause for action and this Appeal Case is herewith **CLOSED**.
