They may also take a note that if they do not submit their response in writing and do not avail themself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date, it will be presumed that they have nothing to say and the Commission will proceed ex-parte on merit. The decision on the reply pertaining to the show cause notice issued to Ms Madhvi so received will be taken on the next date of hearing. Accordingly the case is adjourned.
