PUNJAB STATE INFORMATION COMMISSION, OFFICE ORDER

As per provisions contained in para 4 (iv) of Office Order dated 22.03.2018 issued vide endst. No. PSIC/Legal/Order/2018/98 dated 27.03.2018, the Appeal/Complaint cases which do not meet the requirement or conform to the standard as set out in this Office Order are to be returned to the Appellant/ Complainant for re-submission in proper form, after removal of the deficiencies. The matter has been reconsidered and it has been decided to modify this provision as under:-

- That if any case received from the appellant/complainant is found to be incomplete, the same will not be returned to the sender and only objection memo/ deficiency letter will be sent to him/her through ordinary post.
- That a provisional number will be allotted by the Registry Branch to such b) case and the said number will also be conveyed to the applicant through the above said objection memo/ deficiency letter. He/She will be asked to give reference of this provisional number while resubmitting the documents.
- The applicant will be asked to remove the intimated objection/ deficiency at c) the earliest and to send the same to the Commission within a period not exceeding 60 days from the date of dispatch of the letter of the Commission.
- That in case the requested documents or information are not received in the Commission within the above said period the entire case will be returned to him / her after a period of 60 days.
- That in case the Appeal/ Complaint is not related to this Commission, the e) same will be returned to the Appellant/ Complainant for sending the same to the concerned Information Commission.
